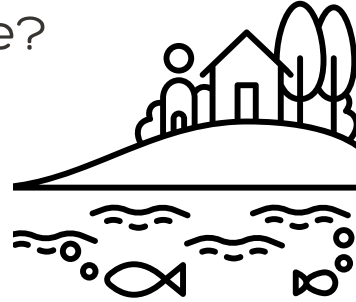

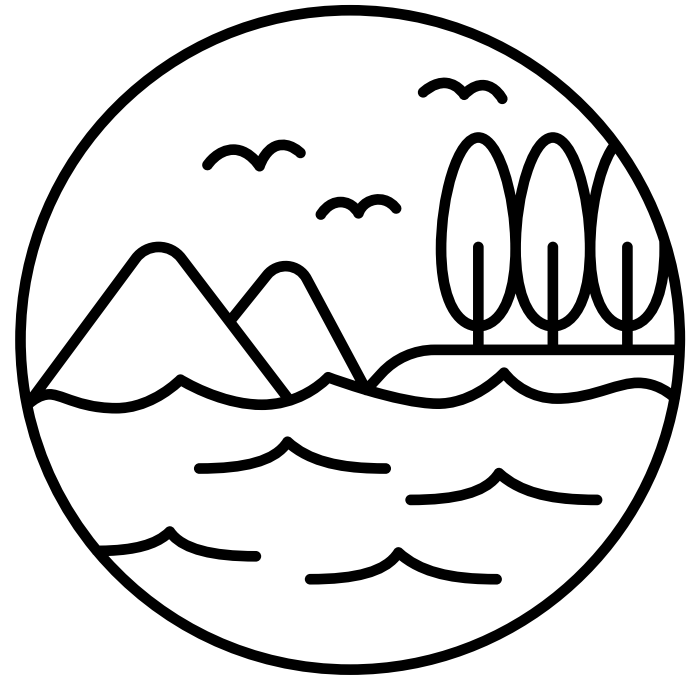

Exploring...

Animals need four things to make a habitat their home:

1. food
2. water
3. cover
4. air

To safely live, not all animals can share the same habitat.

- A black rabbit cannot safely live in the white snow.
- A dolphin cannot safely live on hot sand
