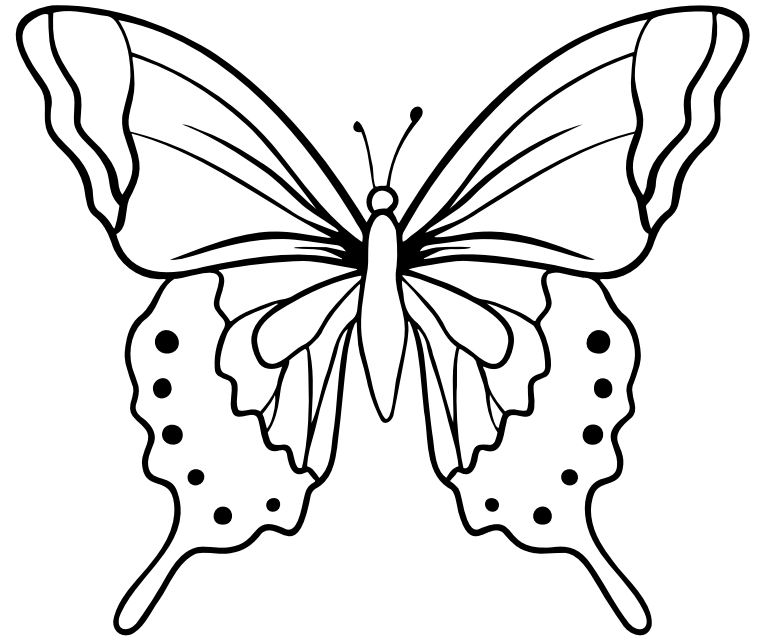

What to do

Hide a Butterfly
