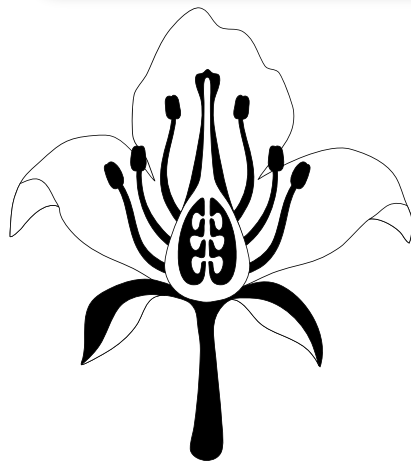

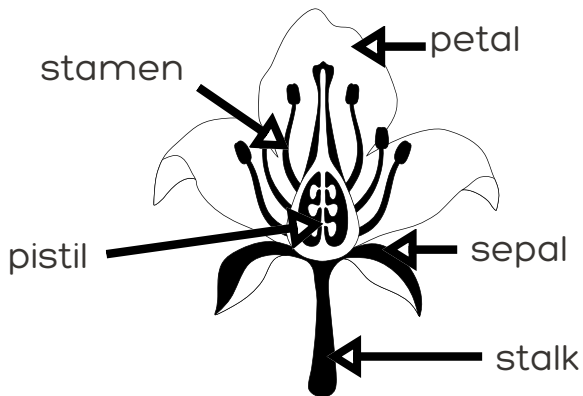

Sepal: holds a growing bud

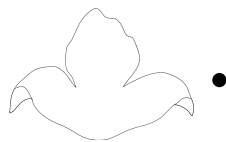
Petal: the colorful part

Pistil: makes fruits and seeds

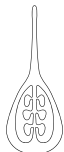

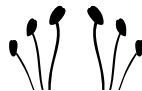

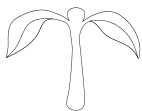
