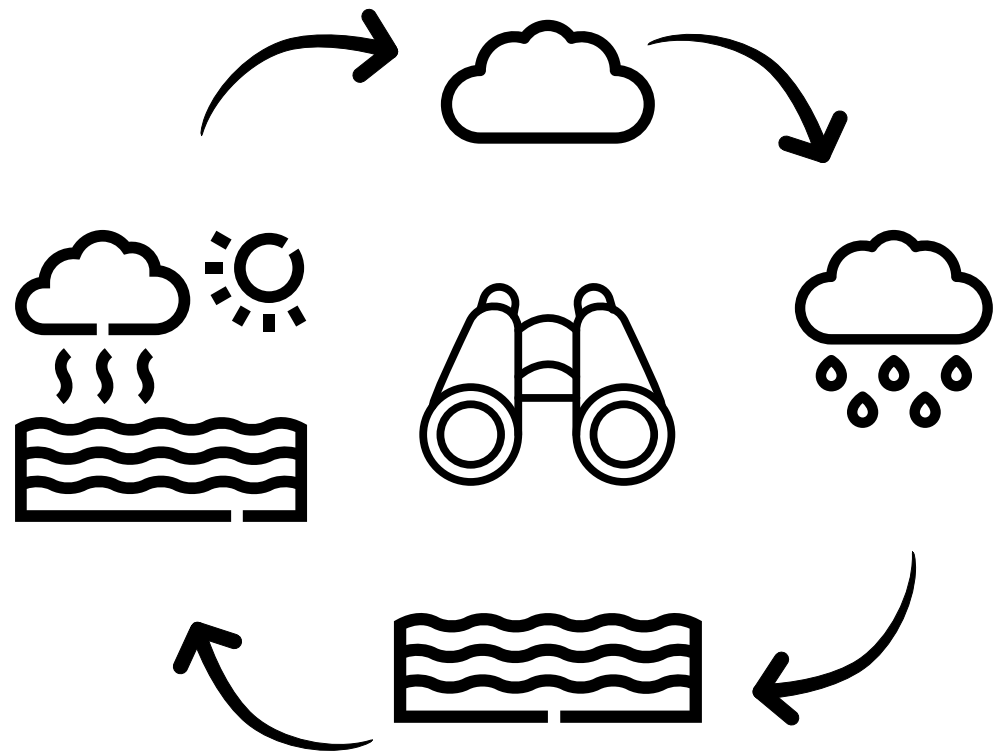

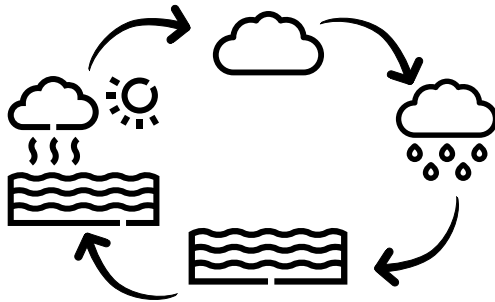
Let's Explore

Water Cycle Watchers: Condensation



Exploring...

Water moves in a pattern.
The pattern repeats over and over.
It is called **the water cycle**.



Condensation is when water vapor becomes a liquid.

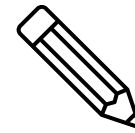
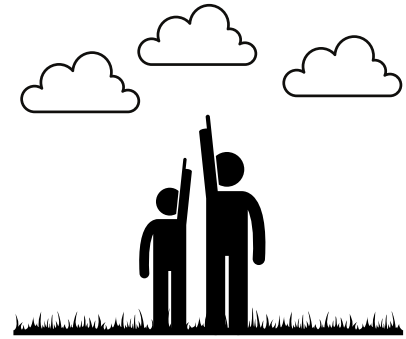
Water vapor is a gas.

This makes clouds!

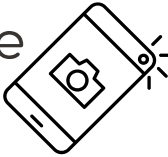


What to do
